STREAM CROSSING!



Due to persistent deep flooding across Coopers Rd in Brendan T Byrne Forest, we have a change for the 2024 Ay Carranza! course. We're using the Mt. Misery (white blaze) Trail, and it is spectacular! It takes you through the Atlantic White Cedar Preserve and passes the abandoned Reeves Cranberry Bogs.

However, this revision has a short stream crossing that was 4 - 5" deep this past weekend, but the water level can vary day-to-day and hour-to-hour. It has rocks under the water, to enable passage of vehicles. Since it is part of a hiking trail there is a rudimentary walkway over the stream. So, whether you choose to ride through it or walk over it, exercise caution, be aware of your fellow riders, and prepare for wet feet. It's all part of an authentic Pine Barrens adventure! The stream crossing is located at approximately these Mile Markers:
